Dan Horvitz

Dan Horvitz, a central figure in the creation and early years of NISS, died on June 1. An obituary from the Raleigh News and Observer accompanies this update. Dan's roles in NISS, some of which were recognized in his 2005 NISS Distinguished Service Award, included bringing together the proposal to locate NISS in North Carolina, helping secure state funding for the original building, and serving on the 1997 building committee. He also established NISS as an organization, writing the articles of incorporation and by-laws, and was the first treasurer.
