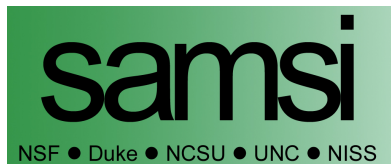

NISS/SAMSI University Affiliates Update April 2007

1. 2007 Affiliates Annual Meeting was held at the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) in Washington on Thursday and Friday, April 26–27, with more than 20 affiliates present. Highlights were the Thursday afternoon new researchers session, Lee Wilkinson’s discussion of the “Analytical Computing Platforms for the Future” initiative and the Friday afternoon problem session.

2. SAMSI. We have just heard from NSF that SAMSI will receive \$2.7 million per year for each of the next five years. This 35% budget increase is a strong recognition from DMS of SAMSI’s success to date. I believe that this award to SAMSI will enable us to proceed with the building expansion, although budgetary and timing uncertainties remain.
